

Tell me more about these birds

- They live for a long time; so far, the oldest of these birds in Malta is 20 years old and still going strong.
- Once the chicks leave the nest, they get no more help from their parents and learn to navigate the open seas and fish alone.
- They can drink seawater and expel the salt through a special gland on their beak.
- Both parents take turns to sit on the nest and can spend a week there without eating.

The LIFE Nature Programme provides funding to European Union countries to promote sustainable development and assist in developing positive management for key habitats and birds.

What is the EU LIFE Yelkouan Shearwater Project about ?

The project aims to protect Yelkouan Shearwaters in Malta. It will also improve the Rdum tal-Madonna site in the North of Malta for wildlife and visitors.

Why is it important?

Malta is home to 1500 pairs of Yelkouan Shearwaters (*Puffinus yelkouan*). That's around 10% of the world's population of this species! It's important at an international level to stop the population from declining.

F'hiex jikkonsisti Proġett Garnija ?

L-iskop ta' dan il-proġett huwa l-harsien tal-garni f'Malta. Dan il-proġett se jtejjeb ukoll l-ambjent naturali ta' Rdum il-Madonna, li jinsab fit-tramuntana ta' Malta.

Għaliex huwa importanti dal-proġett ?

F'Malta jbejtu ma' l-1500 par ta' garni (yelkouan shearwater *Puffinus yelkouan*), jiġifieri 10% tal-popolazzjoni dinjija ta' din l-ispeċi! Għalhekk huwa importanti anke fuq skala globali li nwaqqfu l-popolazzjoni ta' din it-tajra milli tibqa' tonqos.

Why do we need to help the birds ?

The birds have been facing a variety of man-made threats. Here are some of the ways we are going to deal with this:

Threat: Rats are attracted in by rubbish and eat the shearwater chicks.

Action: A rat eradication programme is underway.

Threat: Noise, light and building works can cause birds to abandon their chicks.

Action: We will be working with the authorities to reduce this disturbance. We will advise boat owners to avoid stopping near the area during the breeding season (March to July).

Għaliex għandu bżonn l-għajnuna dan it-tajr ?

Il-garni qed jiffaċċja numru ta' theddid li kollu ġej mill-bniedem. Dawn huma wħud mit-theddud u kif se nippruvaw insolvuhom:

Theddida: L-iskart li jhalli l-bniedem qed iġib il-firien, li jattakkaw u jieklu l-filleles tal-garni.

Azzjoni: Bhalissa għaddejja hidma biex neqirdu l-firien mis-sit.

Theddida: L-istorbu, id-dwal u xogħol ta' żvilupp qed igerrex il-garni minn fuq il-bejtiet.

Azzjoni: Se nkunu qed naħdmu id f'id ma' l-awtoritajiet konċernati biex jitnaqqas dan it-tfixkil. Se nħajru sidien ta' dgħajjes biex waqt l-istaġun tal-bejta (minn Marzu sa Lulju) ma jibqgħux jieqfu jew jankraw, minn tluġ ix-xemx sa nżulha, eqreb minn 2km mill-irdum.

Threat: Accidental catching of birds on longline gear by fishermen.

Action: We will be working with local fishermen to find out if this is a problem and trialling solutions to reduce accidental by-catch.

Threat: Human disturbance from activities such as camping

Action: Our site warden will explain why the site is important and how to protect it. Campers will be asked to avoid certain areas.

Threat: Little is known about the birds' behaviour

Action: We will observe the birds from boats and also fit some electronic devices to find out exactly where they go. This will lead to the creation of a Marine Special Protection Area.

Theddida: Qbid bi żball ta' tajr mis-sajjieda

Azzjoni: Se nkunu qed naħdmu mas-sajjieda biex naraw kemm hija serja din il-problema u nippruvaw soluzzjonijiet biex innaqqsu incidenti ta' dan it-tip.

Theddid: Tfixkil minn attivitajiet tal-bniedem bħalma huwa l-ikkampjar.

Azzjoni: Il-Gwardjan tas-Sit se jkun jispjega għaliex is-sit huwa importanti u dwar il-bżonn li jithares. Min ikun jixtieq jikkampja jintalab biex jevita jtella' tined f'ċerti nħawi.

Theddida: Ftit għadna nafu dwar l-imġiba ta' dan it-tajr

Azzjoni: Se nkunu qed nosservaw dan it-tajr minn fuq dgħajjes, u uħud mit-tajr se jitwaħhallu apparat elettroniku biex jurina fejn eżatt ikun qed imur. Bis-saħħa ta' dan it-tagħrif inkunu nistgħu niddikjaraw Area ta' Harsien Speċjali fil-Baħar.

Who is doing it ?

International and local bodies are sharing their experience in an innovative project partnership of four government authorities and three local and international conservation organisations. The project is 50% funded by the EU LIFE Nature fund, with contributions from MEPA and HSBC.

Where is the project based ?

The main focus is Rdum tal-Madonna. The site is a Special Protection Area (SPA) and a Special Area of Conservation (SAC) under the European "Natura 2000" series of protected areas. Have a look at the map on the back page.
